

Debit Cards & ATMs

WATCH FOR

All existing EMV chip-enabled VISA® debit cards will be changed to new EMV chip-enabled Mastercard® debit cards with a new card number and new Personal Identification Number (PIN) during the banking system changes. You will use your existing VISA® debit card through the banking system changes weekend beginning Friday, October 26th.



WATCH FOR

You should receive your new debit card and new PIN by Monday, October 22nd. Please contact a banking representative if you do not receive both items by this date.

TAKE ACTION

Beginning Monday, October 29th, you must activate and begin using your new Mastercard® debit card and PIN. Your existing VISA® debit card and CardValet™ service will no longer be available on Monday, October 29th. **You will not be able to activate your card until Monday, October 29th.**

TAKE ACTION

Note: If you currently have automatic payments linked to your existing VISA® debit card, you will need to update this payment information with your new Mastercard® debit card number. Your old card number will work through Sunday, October 28th, but for any payments scheduled for Monday, October 29th and beyond the card payment information must be updated.

Apple Pay™ will be available for use beginning Monday, October 29th. Enroll your new debit card in the Apple Wallet™ to enjoy this fast and secure way to pay.

NEW

Beginning Monday, October 29th, you may begin using your new chip-enabled Mastercard® debit card. In addition to all First Landmark Bank and Presto! ATMs, you'll be able to enjoy free ATM use at all National Bank of Commerce locations throughout the Southeast. More information will be provided to you when you receive your Mastercard® debit card in October. First Landmark will no longer be a member of the AllPoint ATM network.

The use of ATMs will be available during the banking system changes weekend using your existing card. **There will be limited account balance availability from Friday, October 26th, through Tuesday, October 30th.**

Direct Deposit and Automatic Payments

Direct deposits, automatic/recurring deductions, or payments scheduled through a third party will continue throughout and after our banking system changes, and your funds will be available. However, deposits and payments made during the banking system changes weekend will not be reflected in inquiries made through Online Banking or at our ATMs until Tuesday, October 30th.
